Value Health Africa (VAHA) is a recognized non-profit organization with a traceable excellent record of accomplishment in improving health and livelihood in Cameroon. They went operational in five regions and have since then supported people living with NCDs since 2016 where they supported communities, engagement programs around NCDs awareness initiatives.

VAHA worked with the Cameroon NCD Alliance to build capacity of people leaving with NCDs to participate in the National and regional advocacy Agenda. Since 2016, VAHA reported having screened over 3000 people on cervical cancer, diabetes, hypertension, prostate and kidney. Also reported 22 cases of cervical cancer; 600 suspected cases on diabetes, 800 on hypertension. VAHA is actually represented at the African NCDs Network with a team member nominated by the Cameroon NCD Alliance as a member of the advisory group to put in place the African regional Advocacy Agenda of people living living with NCDs. During our work with VAHA, I could deduce that they have a well-structured and transparent system. Work with VAHA is very impactful because of their systems of community mobilization.
